



SERVING GOD'S MISSION



SERVING IN GOD'S MISSION

Serving is a lifestyle we live, not an action we turn on or off. **WE ARE FOLLOWERS OF JESUS WHO HELP OTHERS FOLLOW JESUS.** Every person who is a follower of Jesus is a part of fulfilling his mission. We have been saved. But we are also saved for a purpose. His mission is to make disciples of all nations--to help every person come into personal relationship with God, through Jesus, and to help them grow in that relationship.



FRIENDSHIP EVANGELISM

Sharing our faith with our friends, family, coworkers, and the people we have influence with is the most natural way to influence people for Jesus. Investing in relationships through friendship, mentoring, and inviting them into our homes and church community is powerful.

LOCAL COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Getting involved in strategic ways to minister to the non-church community in our local area is another important way we can expand our influence to people who are lost. That involvement may include outreach projects, volunteering with non-profit organizations in the community, praying, or talking about Jesus.

LOCAL CHURCH

Serving in your local church, building mentoring relationships with others, leading groups, and creating a welcoming church environment are ways the local church is accepting and maturing people in the image of God.

GLOBALLY

Every disciple should understand and support God's desire to reach nations with his love and truth. There are still nations and people groups who have never heard of Jesus and who have no hope. As believers, our calling is to take the hope of Jesus to all nations. We can all do that in one of three ways:



Some disciples are called to leave their homes and family and travel to foreign nations to share the gospel. These assignments may be short term or long term.



All disciples can help pray for missionaries who are taking the good news to people around the world.




Some disciples are called to help finance missionaries who travel overseas.

GOD SHAPED YOU FOR A PURPOSE

We have been designed by God, and influenced by life experiences in ways that help us build others up. We are uniquely shaped for service. Ephesians 2:10; Psalm 100:3; Romans 12:6-8; 1 Corinthians 12:12-31.

S - SPIRITUAL GIFTS

Spiritual gifts are divine attributes, given by the Holy Spirit, to every member of the body of Christ. They cannot be earned or achieved, but are free endowments given by God to minister to others, thereby building up the body of Christ. (see Appendix S)

- 1. There are different types of spiritual gifts listed in the scriptures. Romans 12:3-8; Ephesians 4:11-13; 1 Corinthians 12:7-11
- All believers have a variety of spiritual gifts that are used to varying intensities. These gifts influence people in different ways. 1 Peter 4:10; Romans 12:5; Matthew 25:14-30; 1 Corinthians 12:18

H - HEART PASSIONS

A passion is a deep desire, given by God, that compels you to devote your time, resources, and energy toward specific areas of interest or needs. This devotion results in making a difference in the lives of others. Your passion areas may be directed toward certain types of people, various issues or causes, or specific areas of ministry. Philippians 2:13; Revelation 17:17 (see Appendix H)

A - ABILITIES AND TALENTS

A talent or ability is a natural or acquired skill or talent that enables you to excel above others in a specified area. (see Appendix A)

- 1. A person may possess hundreds of talents and abilities. Finding your predominate ones and using them in your place of service will greatly enhance your fruitfulness.
- 2. Talents and abilities may be part of your genetic code, while other skills may be acquired. They may be used in both natural and spiritual arenas.

P - PERSONALITY

God gives each person a unique personality, mode of thinking, and set of internal characteristics that determine how we relate to every person, situation, and daily challenge. Being aware of your personality type will help you know how to better serve others with satisfaction and fruitfulness. Psalm 139:13-14 (see Appendix P)

E - LIFE EXPERIENCES

Life experiences are your personal history-- the memories you've made and the trauma or blessings you've lived through. These events or seasons influence your perception of the world. God wants to use all your life experiences, good and bad, for his purposes. Romans 8:28 (see Appendix E)

Here are a few examples:

- Family life
- Education
- Career history
- Ministry experiences
- Tragedies, trials, and challenges
- Great accomplishments and victories

NEXT STEPS

Serving is a lifestyle, not a volunteer position. Regardless of where you serve in the church or in the local community, you represent Jesus and his church. Serving is not defined by position, time, or location; a servant is always ready to serve anyone, anywhere.

A. SERVE WHEREVER THERE IS A NEED

There are always opportunities to serve, both within the church and within the local community. Sometimes it is appropriate to serve regardless of our S-H-A-P-E, simply because there's a need.

B. IDENTIFY YOUR S-H-A-P-E

Take the time to go through the S-H-A-P-E assessments in the back of this section. Then consider serving somewhere your S-H-A-P-E fits best.

C. SIGN UP FOR A "BELONG LAUNCH CONVERSATION"

The BELONG Launch Conversation is a personal meeting with a pastor or connections consultant who will help you evaluate your S-H-A-P-E assessments and discuss next steps you could be passionate about.

D. CONTACT A MINISTRY LEADER

If you are already confident you know how you'd like to be involved you can contact the ministry leader and ask for the steps necessary to begin serving. Contact information can be found in the "*Serve*" booklet.

E. COMMIT

Be faithful and show up, ready to serve. Be willing to serve in whatever ways they need help. Serve with excellence. Be responsible. Represent the church and your ministry area well. Allow time for relationships and trust to grow, for giftings to be recognized, and character to be discerned.

SPIRITUAL GIFT DEFINITIONS

Proclamation

The God-given ability to proclaim the truth of God and the mind of God with boldness, which brings conviction to the hearers regardless of the consequences. Acts 2:14-40; Acts 7:1-60; Acts 17:32-34, Acts 26:24-29; I Thess. 1:5

Craftsmanship/Artistic

The God-given ability to further the kingdom of God through artistic, creative means. Ex. 30:22-25; Ex. 31:3-11; Acts 9:39; Acts 16:14

Apostle

The God-given ability and calling to plant, establish, and give general leadership over a number of churches with a unique authority in spiritual matters which is spontaneously recognized and appreciated by those churches. This gift can function on a lay level of helping plant churches and new ministries but is most often considered a five-fold leadership gift as seen in Ephesians 4:11. I Cor. 3:10; I Cor. 12:28; I Cor. 12:12; Acts 15:1-2; Gal. 2:7-10

Hospitality

The God-given ability to use your home as a means to entertain and bless the people of God or those in need of food and shelter. It also includes the ministry of making people feel welcomed in the church. Rom. 12:13; Rom. 16:23; Acts 16:14-15; I Peter 4:9; Heb.13:1-2

Teaching

The God-given ability to search out and expound to others spiritual truth from the Word of God in a systematic way so that others will learn. This gift can function on the lay level or on a five-fold leadership level as seen in Ephesians 4:11. Rom. 12:7; Acts 18:16; Col. 3:16

Missionary

The God-given ability and calling to use your spiritual gifts to minister to those of another culture on a long-term basis. I Cor. 9:19-23; Acts 8:4; Acts 13:2-3; Acts 22:21; Rom. 10:15

Helps

The God-given ability to invest the talents you have in the life and ministry of others. The desire to be available to help out in any area where there is a need. I Cor.12:28; Roms.16:1,2; Acts 9:36; Luke 8:2,3; Mark 15:40-41

Tongues

The God-given gift to speak to God in a language you have never learned. This can be either a personal prayer language for personal edification and intercession and/or the spontaneous gift to receive and communicate an immediate message of God to his people in a language you never learned. It may involve the language of men or the supernatural language of angels. I Cor. 12:10; I Cor. 14:2, 3, 13-19; Mark 16:17; Acts 2:1-13; Acts 10:44-49

Exhortation

The God-given ability to minister words of comfort, consolation, encouragement, and counsel to others in such a way that they would be helped or healed. Roms.12:8; I Tim. 4:13; Heb. 10:25; Acts 14:22

Music/Vocal

The God-given ability to use one's voice in the singing of praises and joy to the Lord for the benefit of others. I Chron. 15:16; II Chron. 5:12-13; II Chron. 20:21; Deut. 31:22; Judges 5:3

Evangelist

The God-given ability and calling to share the gospel with unbelievers in such a way that men and women turn from sin and make commitments to serve Jesus Christ. Some with this gift work primarily within the realm of the local church community; others have broader ministries throughout the world on a five0fold leadership level as seen in Ephesians 4:11. II Tim. 4:5; Acts 8:5-6, 26-40; Acts 14:21; Acts 21:8

Healing

The God-given spontaneous gift to minister at specific times physical, spiritual, or emotional healing to those in need apart from natural means. I Cor. 12:9; Acts 3:1-10; Acts 5:12, 16; Acts 9:32-35; Acts 28:7-10; Mk. 16:17-18

Administration

The God-given ability to understand clearly the immediate and long-range goals of a particular problem or need in the Body of Christ and to devise, organize, and execute effective plans for the accomplishment of these goals. I Cor. 12:28; Acts 6:1-7; Acts 27:11; Luke 14:28-30; Titus 1:5

Miracles

The God-given spontaneous gift in which God uses you to perform an act which transcends the laws of nature. I Cor. 12:10, 28; II Cor. 12:12; Acts 9:36-40; Acts 19:11-20; Romans 15:18-19

Pastor

The God-given ability and calling to commit yourself to the care and nurture of members of the Body of Christ. This motivation may be directed to children, youth, or adults. It may function on a lay level of care or a fivefold leadership level in the church as seen in Ephesians 4:11. I Peter 5:1-3; I Tim. 3:1-7; John 10:1-18

Faith

The God-given gift to believe for the impossible which is beyond the normal faith potential. It is the impartation of faith to accomplish a specific task, face potentially overwhelming circumstances, or persevere when facing dangerous situations. I Cor. 12:9; Acts 16:16-18; Acts 11:22-24; Acts 27:21-25; Romans 4:18-21

Service

The God-given ability to identify the unmet needs involved in a task related to God's work and to use your time and resources to meet the practical material needs involved. This gift, in contrast to the Gift of Helps, is more intentional in identifying needs and taking the initiative to do something about it. Romans 12:7; Acts 6:1-7; Galatians 6:2,10; II Tim. 1:16-18; Titus 3:14 -18

Discernment of Spirits
